"Summer of Mercy" event leads Leroy Carhart to close late-term abortion facility for a week



*Abortionist Leroy Carhart
commits late-term abortions

month to commit abortions

Germantown, MD—
A 9-day pro-life
event in early August,
lead by Operation Rescue
President Troy Newman,
Pro-Life Action League
Director Joe Scheidler
and a coalition of
other national pro-life
leaders has led to the
week-long closing of
a notorious late-term
abortion facility. LeRoy
Carhart, who commits
late-term abortions at the
Germantown Reproductive Health Services
facility in Germantown, MD, announced
just before the "Summer of Mercy" brought

hundreds of pro-lifers from across the country
to Germantown that he would be closing his
abortion facility for the week.

"This is a huge victory," Operation Rescue
President Troy Newman told Lifenews.com.
"While this event is in progress no babies will
die in Germantown. This is an answer to our
prayers."

During the Summer of Mercy 2.0 event, pro-
life participants converged on Germantown
Reproductive Health Services three times a
day for formal prayer, worship and keynote
speeches by national pro-life leaders. Smaller
groups of pro-life activists continued to hold
vigil between the rallies throughout the entire
9-day event.

In addition to his late-term abortion business
in Maryland, LeRoy Carhart also flies to
Indianapolis twice a month to commit
abortions at Affiliated Women's Services.
Troy Newman and the staff at Operation
Rescue have catalogued numerous abuses,
criminal investigations and shoddy medical
practices committed by Carhart in Nebraska
and Maryland. Operation Rescue is currently
working with local pro-life activists across the
country to bring attention to Carhart's record

and the danger he presents to the communities
where he commits abortions.

"After years of investigation, we can confidently
say that Carhart is a dishonest man who is a
danger to the public that belongs behind bars,"
said Newman. "We are using every legal tool
available to expose abortion abuses and see to
it that abortionists like Carhart are arrested and
jailed and their clinics closed."
